



Application Process

To apply to Grace Community Academy, visit www.gcacademysc.org/admissions and click on the link to “Apply Now.” Follow the directions to complete and submit the application online.

Enrollment priority and waitlist status are on a first-come, first-serve basis determined by the date the application is completed. An application is not considered complete until GCA has received the following items:

- Completed Application (*online*)
- Signed Statement of Faith (*online - one per family*)
- Pastoral Recommendation (*online - one per family*)
- Parent Questionnaire (*online - for each child applying for admission*)
- Provide a copy of all psychological reports, accommodation plans, or IEPs (*if applicable*)
- Application Fee of \$125 (*online or check made out to Grace Community Academy - per student*)

*Intentionally omitting relevant information or failure to provide all relevant documentation, including but not limited to the above-listed items, is cause for nullification of enrollment.

Once the application has been submitted, GCA will:

- Request school records from your child’s current school.
- Schedule an assessment to determine grade placement for each student applying.
- Schedule a Family Meeting to go over grade placement and any final questions.
- The enrollment decision is made by the Admissions Committee after the Family Meeting.
