### General Information for Part-Time Students

Grace Community Academy High School courses are taught by faculty certified through AACSB in the subject matter of their classes. GCA is accredited through SCACS, AACSB, and Cognia.

Part-time students are eligible to enroll in up to three courses. All courses (except Biology, Drama, and Culinary Arts) require a relevant academic assessment and completed prerequisites.

Core courses meet three days a week at Grace Community Academy. Elective courses meet two days a week.

Elective courses require an additional elective fee that varies by course.

## Part-Time Courses and Prerequisites

### World Literature 1 (9th and 10th)

*Prerequisites: Reading and writing assessment, grade of C or above in most recent literature course, Expected familiarity with writing analytical, thesis-driven essays with text-based proofs.*

### World History 1 (9th and 10th)

*Prerequisites: Reading and writing assessments, grade of C or above in most recent history course, Expected familiarity with writing analytical, thesis-driven essays with text-based proofs.*

### Biology - (9th and 10th)

*Prerequisites: Grade of C or above in most recent science course. Students who have completed a course in introductory physics and chemistry will find this course easier. However, it is not required. This course requires frequent lab reports.*

### Chemistry - (9th and 10th)

*Prerequisites: Math assessment, Grade of C or above in most recent science course. Students who have completed a course in introductory physics and chemistry will find this course easier. However, it is not required. This course requires frequent lab reports and mathematical calculations.*

### Algebra I (9th)

*Prerequisites: Math assessment, Grade of C or above in Pre-Algebra.*

### Geometry (10th and 11th)

*Prerequisites: Math assessment, Grade of C or above in Algebra I.*

### Drama (9th-12th)

*No prerequisites. Requires participation outside of class time.*

### Intro to Culinary Arts (9th-12th)

*No prerequisites*

Registration	\$150 per course	Upon Acceptance, annually with registration
Tuition per course	\$800	Single Payment Due June 15th or 11 payments on the 15th of each month, June-May.

### Application Fee

The non-refundable/non-transferable Application Fee is due with the student application. The Application Fee is per student and covers administrative and student assessment costs.

### Registration Fee

All Registration Fees are non-refundable and non-transferable. Students will pay a registration fee upon acceptance, submitted with a signed Enrollment Agreement and Financial Agreement. Returning students will pay a registration fee for the following year when they register for classes.

### Tuition Payment Options

Tuition may be paid through a one-time payment by June 15th or upon acceptance (if after June 15th). Tuition may also be paid through 11 monthly payments from June to May of each school year. There are no tuition payments in March, when the Annual Registration Fee is due. Full financial policies can be found in the Financial Agreement and Family Handbook.

### Discounts and Scholarships

Discounts and scholarships are not available to part-time students, except in conjunction with siblings who are full-time students. For part-time students who have siblings who are full-time students, the discount and scholarship policy for full-time students is applied to the family as a whole.

### Tuition

Part-time students are eligible to enroll in courses that add up to no more than 3 courses.. If a student desires to take more than 3 courses, they will need to enroll as a full-time student.

### Additional Expected Expenses

In order to prepare budgetarily while considering tuition, here are some of the major and routine expenses you can expect to incur as a GCA family. Each expense is per student. These are estimates only—actual expenses may vary. Student groups may organize fundraising activities to lower the cost of some trips.

Field trips\* (per quarter) \$10-\$30; Spirit wear \$20-\$50; Class trips\*\* (5th-12th grade) \$250-\$550; Raptor Retreat\*\* (7th-12th grade) \$200; Elective fees (5th-12th grade) \$25-\$150

\*Field Trips related to the course a part-time student is enrolled in are not optional. School or class-wide field trips are optional for part-time students. Field trips not related to the course a part-time student is enrolled in are not available for part-time students.

\*\*Class Trips and the Raptor Retreat are optional for part-time students and available only if space allows. For budgetary purposes, part-time students are required to sign up for the Raptor Retreat upon enrollment and the Class Trip at the beginning of the school year. The GCA Administration may decline to invite part-time students at its discretion.
